Customer info

This round wood refuge has a wood-burning stove, bunk beds and a camping table. The refuge can accommodate 4 persons. There's a dry pit toilet on the site. There's no firewood in the refuge. The maintenance is the users' responsibility.

There's a watering place near the campground. The water may not be drinkable: it's recommended to boiled water or even treated it with some product.

You must bring your own tent, sleeping bag, mattress, camping stove (camping heater), matches, pocket lamp, plates and utensils, food, toilet paper, first aid kit.

Camping is allowed in the site but there's no platform.

Fires are not allowed

Old hunting camp of the 80's, reconditioned but still rustic.
