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Report of the State of the trail leading to the Bascon Creek and mount

- The bridge to go to the chute Hélène is broken. The 2nd pillar is more the bridge and the first is on the edge of falling. Also, the roasting on a part of the bridge is pull. It would be nice to put across the bridge pillars, this much better stabilize the bridge.
- The indicator Panel, about 1 km before the Creek campground bascon at the intersection of 2 forest roads was completely destroyed.
- On the logging roads, it would be nice to add tags. At some point we wonder if it is still on the trail.
- The door of the Bascon Creek is in a pitiful state. The window is broken and the door also and all is with grey tape.
- Just before the Bascon Creek, there is an indication for the mount Collins and the Logan. Approximately 50 m further on, there is a sign indicating the Matawe. Here is what the question or gone. The trail to the Matawe is very well indicated, but for the Bobwhites, is much less. Before find the first tag, should be approximately 500 m (trail leading to the Northern Bobwhite).
- Support to bear is very difficult to find. Me I thought it was by chance the 2nd day. It would be nice to put a sign to indicate. The rope to climb the food is missing, I used mine.
- At the camp, there were 4 sites of fire and a former site of fire. The former site of fire is pasted on the refuge. It was too difficult to put leave no trace, I therefore left it in place. I have defeated two sites, one who was using the toilet and the other in front of a platform. I left in place the site between 2 platforms and one in front of the sanctuary. The site in front of the sanctuary is very close to the stairs, so that it is obliged to work around this issue when it descends, it is pasted on the last step. There were large half burnt trunks around before the refuge. I have handed over in the forest for not that it bothers the Visual and all CEW cleaner.

- The trail to the Matawe is very beautiful and very well develop. There were several trees of dark, I have identified a dozen with my sciotte. There are 3 that was too big so I cut. The first, it is the height of the knees and should be over. The second, a fir tree as a whole, must be circumvented. The third, it should go below, I had to cut some branches to allow passage. If not, the rest of the path of the road to the camp is very beautiful. I don't have the trail leading to the Northern Bobwhite.

- There were many waste everywhere on the site of camp. There were plenty of plastic bottles, remains of canned, box of old bottles of gas for the stoves and not decomposed food leftovers (this indicates that there have been people a few days before me, there were also 3 cut trees that were still green.) I have all reduced waste to leave the own site.

I hope that my comment will help you to improve the trail.
